Description

During parent conferences on October 29, 2015 I handed out information about Remind which is a way for me to send out group text messages to parents who sign up. For the parents who I have not met with, I sent home the information in the student's Friday folders. By Sunday morning I already had 3 parents from my partner teacher's homeroom and 4 parents from my homeroom.


Impact

My wife has been using Remind now for a couple of years. She has told me that it has helped her with her school to home communication. She explains that too often there is a communication break down when you send information home with the students. With Remind she doesn't have to rely on the students giving the information to their parents once they get home. This communication tool allows her to get the information directly to the person who needs it. For me, I can't believe it has taken me this long to begin using it. In addition to my wife telling me about it I have heard about at the E-Tech conference I attended last year, and it has been discussed in some of my Akron classes. With several parents signing up for it after just days, it confirms that parents want to know what is going on in their child's classroom. I wasn't sure of the response I would get, but I am even more encouraged and motivated to start using Remind.

Intent

For the immediate future I want to see if more parents will sign up for Remind. In a few days from November 1, 2015 I will again check to see if more parents have signed up. By the end of the week I will send out my first group text message thanking the parents for signing up and confirming that it works. After I use it a few times I will ask for some feedback from the parents on how it is working and what type of group messages they want sent using Remind. This will allow me to use it efficiently and effectively. After I get some feedback from the parents, I will send out more information on how to sign up for Remind to the parents who haven't signed up and explain to them how other parents have benefited from using it. My goal is to get at least 50% of my parents signed up before winter break and then continue working on getting more parents signed up by the end of the school year. I have already explained to the parents that the plan is to send out messages that pertain to school-wide events like fundraisers and book fairs as well as things happening in the classroom like when projects are due or test dates. If all goes well, this will be something that I use at the beginning of the school year next year.

Once I have more experience using Remind, I plan on training other teachers in my building how to use it and how it has benefited myself, the students, and the parents.
